Dear Wansford Resident,

As advised in the October 2024 Living Villages article, Wansford Parish Council is considering producing a Neighbourhood Plan (NP). A NP gives a community direct power to develop a shared vision for its neighbourhood and to shape the development and growth of its local area. The importance of a NP and its production is that it is <u>community-led</u>. Participation by residents is vital to ensure the community as a whole is engaged. By this means the community can influence the future shape of its environment and what infrastructure should be provided. Benefits of a NP enables the community to play a much stronger role in setting out a positive, proactive approach to shape and direct changes to meet local needs.

During a public meeting (18 Nov. 2024) it was confirmed that both <u>Peterborough City Council</u> and <u>Huntingdon District Council</u> are actively consulting on their Local Plans which propose significant new developments. For instance, Wansford could be impacted by a proposed site off Old Leicester Road (Seeds Field) and three sites in Huntingdon: Sibson Garden Community; Chesterton Garden Village and Land West of A1 (North of Peterborough Motorway Services).

With this in mind, it was agreed that conducting a survey of Wansford residents is a priority, initially to establish a Wansford Designated Neighbourhood Forum to produce a NP.

Once the NP is approved by the Government planning inspectorate and a local referendum, future developments in Wansford must comply with the Wansford NP. Producing a NP is a demanding project and will only be delivered through the support of our local community.

Would you consider offering your assistance developing Wansford's NP?
